Scholarship Policy and Award Procedure

The NLICA Memorial Scholarship is a \$1000.00 scholarship to be awarded one time to:

An active NLICA contractor member, who has been in the association for two years or more; their spouse - their children or step-children - their grandchildren or step grandchildren

Procedure:

Student requests a scholarship application from the NLICA Executive Director

Student completes the application and includes essay, grade point average, relation to paid contractor member and proves acceptance to a college of their choice.

Student sends the application into the Executive Director post marked no later than April 10. Applications post marked after April 10th will not be considered.

Executive Director verifies eligibility and sends copies of application to Scholarship Committee for review and selection.

Chairperson of said committee to contact Executive Director with selection of winner
Executive Director will then notify the winner by mail.

Scholarship will be given only to students who have been accepted by an accredited college or University for admission in the fall of the same year the award is granted.

Upon proof of school registration the Executive Director will inform the Treasurer of NLICA to send the scholarship payment to the award recipient made out jointly to the student and the school. Applicants who are in their senior year of high school will be awarded the scholarship the second semester of enrollment. Those who are attending a college and apply for this scholarship will receive it in the fall.
